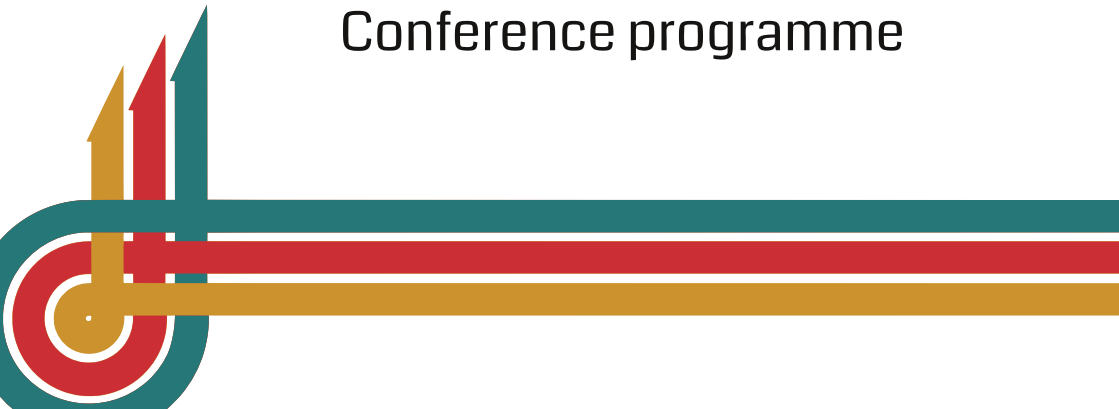

Korsvägen

Close to the conference venue, Korsvägen is a public transport hub where you will find tram number 2, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 13 as well as many bus lines.
